




#### GLORY TO GOD

#### THE SECOND READING

Brothers and sisters:

Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen.

Because of it the ancients were well attested.

By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to a place that he was to receive as an inheritance;

he went out, not knowing where he was to go.

By faith he sojourned in the promised land as in a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, heirs of the same promise; for he was looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and maker is God.

By faith he received power to generate, even though he was past the normal age

-and Sarah herself was sterile-

for he thought that the one who had made the promise was trustworthy.

So it was that there came forth from one man, himself as good as dead, descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and as countless as the sands on the seashore.

All these died in faith.

They did not receive what had been promised but saw it and greeted it from afar and acknowledged themselves to be strangers and aliens on earth, for those who speak thus show that they are seeking a homeland. If they had been thinking of the land from which they had come, they would have had opportunity to return.
But now they desire a better homeland, a heavenly one.
Therefore, God is not ashamed to be called their God,

and will punish the servant severely


and assign him a place with the unfaithful. That servant who knew his master's will

but did not make preparations nor act in accord with his will shall be beaten severely;


and the servant who was ignorant of his master's will but acted in a way deserving of a severe beating


shall be beaten only lightly. Much will be required of the person entrusted with much,

and still more will be demanded of the person entrusted with more."








