Administrator's Update (Felipe)

Christmas Concert with Jonn Angotti was very well attended and it was live streamed.

Feedback was that the food truck that was provided during the break between Mass and the concert was great and we should consider doing more of this. A special thanks to all those

that helped with all the Masses and planning - a lot of effort went into this.

• Los Posados - about 15% of attendees were from St. Monica with most coming from our

partner parishes. How can we increase our engagement in this?

Development Update (Merrick)

• Between Thanksgiving, Adopt a Family, Christmas and Africa appeal, we were about 19%

above budgeted collections. Thank you to all those who helped and contributed!

• Together In Mission: we were 102% of the expectation. 2024 will see a 21% decrease in the amount expected by the diocese for our parish. Bishop Elshoff will be speaking to students

this year during this drive.

• Called to Renew: Raised slightly over the goal with about 70% actually already paid. This is

great news.

• New website will soft launch on Feb 26. Ministries will have an opportunity to review prior

to the launch in March.

- Women's Cornerstone: During the marketing of the Men's retreat over the past weeks, there is excitement for the Women's retreat to return in 2025 and quite a few women have been asking for this.
