- Kelly and subcommittee have completed the latest updates to the Parish Council Covenant book and members present signed it. Those online, please get Kelly your signature page.

School Update (Kevin)

- East Wing flood renovation is continuing. The plan for next school year is to have the first
 and top floors open. However, the basement will not be open until the following year. The
 STEM Academy will create a semi-permanent space on the top floor for next year. It will
 include installing sinks and other equipment needed so labs can take place and the Maker
 Space can get going fully again. Insurance negotiation and consultation with the city is
 ongoing and impacts being assessed.
- SMASH is Sat, May 11! Fr. Bob Dowd is the honoree this year.
- TK-12 Integration continuing with curriculum alignment, school families and more.
- Experiential Education this year included trips to Japan, Cost Rica, Washington DC, NY, a France exchange program, Africa and other more local outings.
- Grade level retreats are being held with option for parents to attend. This has helped us to reach and minister to families and get them more integrated into the school and parish. A number of Lower and Upper school students have chosen to be baptized.
- Tuition was raised over the past two years to keep up with expenses. Focus on development has kept enrollment higher than where it would otherwise be expected.

- Construction on campus
 - Hospitality suite is underway and be completed in a few weeks.
 - Duval to being this summer restrooms especially to be revamped, some finishings upgrades to building
 - Auditorium plans submitted to city and bidding process hope to start construction
 Dec of this year
